Traffic Safety—Changes on Honors!

Thank you all for your dedication to the safety of our children here by abiding by the driving and parking policies in and around our school. In working with the Irvine Police Department, we have two changes that go into place over the Winter Break.

- 1) There will be NO PARKING on Honors immediately prior to the entrance into the parking lot. Previously, cars could park along this lane, but it caused a tremendous back up. Many drivers would attempt to go around this back up and would then enter the lane of oncoming traffic. By not having cars park along the curb between the school and the park, we can have the drivers that want to enter the parking lot move closer to the curb allowing for others to legally pass. Here is a picture of the area that will no longer allow parking...in between the two, red arrows. It will be noted with signs stating **NO STOPPING 7AM TO 4PM SCHOOL DAYS**
- 2) On Honors, there will be "NO UTURN" signs posted between both entrances into the parking lot. You may, however, make legal U-Turns at the intersection of Honors and Encore.
