

Dear Parents,

In conjunction with our PTA Board, I would like to share our recommendations to improve the traffic flow for Vista Verde both in the morning drop-off and in the afternoon pick-up of students.

- The red curb is for emergency vehicles only – you may not park along the red curb.
- The yellow curb is for active loading and unloading of students. **YOU MAY NOT PARK AND LEAVE YOUR CAR AT ANY TIME.**
- The left lane is ONLY for passing or for people who need to park in the parking lot. No parking, pickup, or drop off. It is constantly moving.
- Do not weave into the loading zone from the passing lane. It causes further congestion and it is unsafe as cars are attempting to exit the loading zone after dropping off their children.
- Please pull forward along the yellow curb as much as possible. The yellow curb extends from the front of the school to the front of CDC.
- If you have a child with a large musical instrument, please either park in our parking lot or that of Las Lomas to assist them. You may not leave your car.
- Consider car-pooling – fewer cars, less gas expense, more time for you.
- Use the cross-walks (there are several: one is in front of CDC, one is in front of the school, another is across the Las Lomas parking lot).
- Cooperate and follow the directions of our Viking Valets, staff, and parent volunteers – they are assisting you to keep our children safe.
- Primary afternoon pick-up is adjacent to CDC, upper grade is adjacent to the kinder gate, middle school is the front of the school.
- You may not park at any curb within the parking lot.
- You may not park, drop-off or pick-up in the parking lanes inside the parking lot – use the parking stalls.
- Follow the parking lot traffic arrows – the traffic flow design was determined by IPD, City Traffic Officials, and IUSD for maximum efficiency and safety.

Please embrace our STAR philosophy by being respectful and cooperative to others while driving in our parking lot. Thank you.
