The following activities are for those who would like to be challenged. Please choose 2 activities per week and turn them in with regular homework on Friday. Complete these activities on separate pieces of paper. We are looking forward to seeing your outstanding work!

1. Language Arts: Make a list of five February things, (i.e. holidays, symbols, etc.) Draw the five things and label them.
2. Reading: Find a book about a famous person born in February. Draw a picture and write three facts you learned about this person.

6. Science: Find information about plants. Use the library, internet, etc.. Write three facts about plants.
