



March Enrichment Activities

The following activities are suggested for those who want to be challenged. You may choose 2 activities per week.

1. Language Arts: Make a small booklet of your favorite nursery rhymes. Write the words and make a picture for each.

2. Reading: Find a book about Spring. Draw a picture and write three facts you learned about the season.

3. Creative Writing: Write a personal narrative story about your favorite family fun time. Ask a parent to help edit your work.

4. Social Studies: Make a list of patriotic holidays when it is appropriate to fly the American flag.

5. Math: Survey six people. Ask them what their favorite kind of food is. Make a graph to show your findings. Ask family members, friends and neighbors. Then make a list of ten healthy food you like to eat.



6. Science: Look up information about what animals do in the spring. Write three facts you learned.

7. Math (Logic): Make a list of all the kinds of farm animals that you can think of. Next write the number of legs each of these animals have. Finally, write the numbers of legs there would be if you had three of each of the animals on the list.

8. Art: Make a picture of a four leaf clover. Be creative! Then write five reasons why you think you are lucky!

9. Just For Fun!!! Make a list of as many things that you can think of that come in threes!
