



Alderwood Elementary School Drop-off and Pick-up of Students

When selecting your family's plan for morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up, please be aware of the following:

1. All of the areas in **green** are available for parking your vehicle and leaving it while you drop-off or pick-up your youngsters.
2. All of the areas in **yellow** are available for drop-off or pick-up, **but the driver must remain in the vehicle.**
3. All of the areas in **red** are **never available** - you may not stop or park at any time.
4. The 3 areas in **blue** are pedestrian crosswalks, and are the **ONLY** means of crossing traffic, **both in the large parking lot and on Knollcrest.**

The big parking lot:

If you choose to go into the large parking lot in the morning, plan on spending 15-20 minutes. Please notice that we have added orange cones to reduce the left turn into the drop-off area to ONE lane.

We also have a fence around the shrubbery, so everyone will have to walk to the crosswalk. Please do not cross the traffic at the bike rack end of the parking lot - go to the crosswalk at the other end.

The small parking lot: is closed to all traffic, and is staff parking only. The area near the small parking lot (walkway and steps) is for use by parents of KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS ONLY. If you have a student in grade 1-6, please use the lunch table side of the school to pick up or drop off your child.

Knollcrest:

Certain sections are now available to park between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. (check the new signs for specifics-**DON'T STOP IN THE RED**)

You may park on either side of Knollcrest and walk your child. If you need to cross Knollcrest you must go to the crossing guard.

Please remember---

All of these directions are **for the safety of children and adults**, not for convenience. Our Irvine Police officers do enforce these traffic regulations, both on and off the campus. Parents/guardians who do not follow these directions will receive a citation from the Irvine Police-- rain or shine.
