

Alderwood Basics Plus School Lunch Program

- 1. Each student, Gr. 1-6, is expected to bring a lunch from home or have funds available to purchase lunch in his/her lunch account every day. Each lunch sells for \$3.25 (10 lunches = \$32.50). Milk only is sold for 75¢ (3 quarters). The menu is at IUSD.org (click on Business Services and then Nutrition Services). If your child is new to the school, please allow two weeks for a PIN number to be assigned. You may send the student with \$3.25 cash or a sack lunch until a PIN number is assigned.**
- 2. IT IS THE PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO MONITOR THE CHILD'S LUNCH ACCOUNT BALANCE ON-LINE. IT IS NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE FOOD SERVICE WORKER OR THE SCHOOL OFFICE TO MONITOR THE BALANCE OF YOUR CHILD'S LUNCH ACCOUNT. The Alderwood office does not have access to your account. A deposit to replenish the account should be made when the account is getting low. We prefer to receive checks in our office (same-day credit) because electronic deposits are not credited the same day. Funds not used by the last day of school will roll over to the next year.**
- 3. The school office does not loan lunch money. If your child does not have a lunch or lunch funds, he/she will be asked to call you at lunch time so that you can bring a lunch.**
- 4. Students are not allowed to "share" their account funds with other students.**
- 5. Students are not able to purchase an extra slice of pizza on "Pizza Day". If they want an extra slice of pizza, they will have to purchase another whole meal for \$3.25.**
- 6. If a child brings a sack lunch from home and decides to purchase lunch instead, you will notice this when you monitor the account. You will see the debit. You can also monitor how many lunches your child is purchasing per day (usually applies to older students taking two lunches).**
- 7. If school has started and you deliver a lunch to school, it must be labeled and placed on the LUNCH DROP-OFF CART located near our lunch room door. Late-arriving lunches ARE NOT delivered to the students. Instruction will not be interrupted. Students are NOT notified. Make certain that your child knows to pick his/her lunch up from the LUNCH DROP-OFF CART at lunch time. Make certain that your child knows to notify the office whenever he/she does not have a lunch.**
