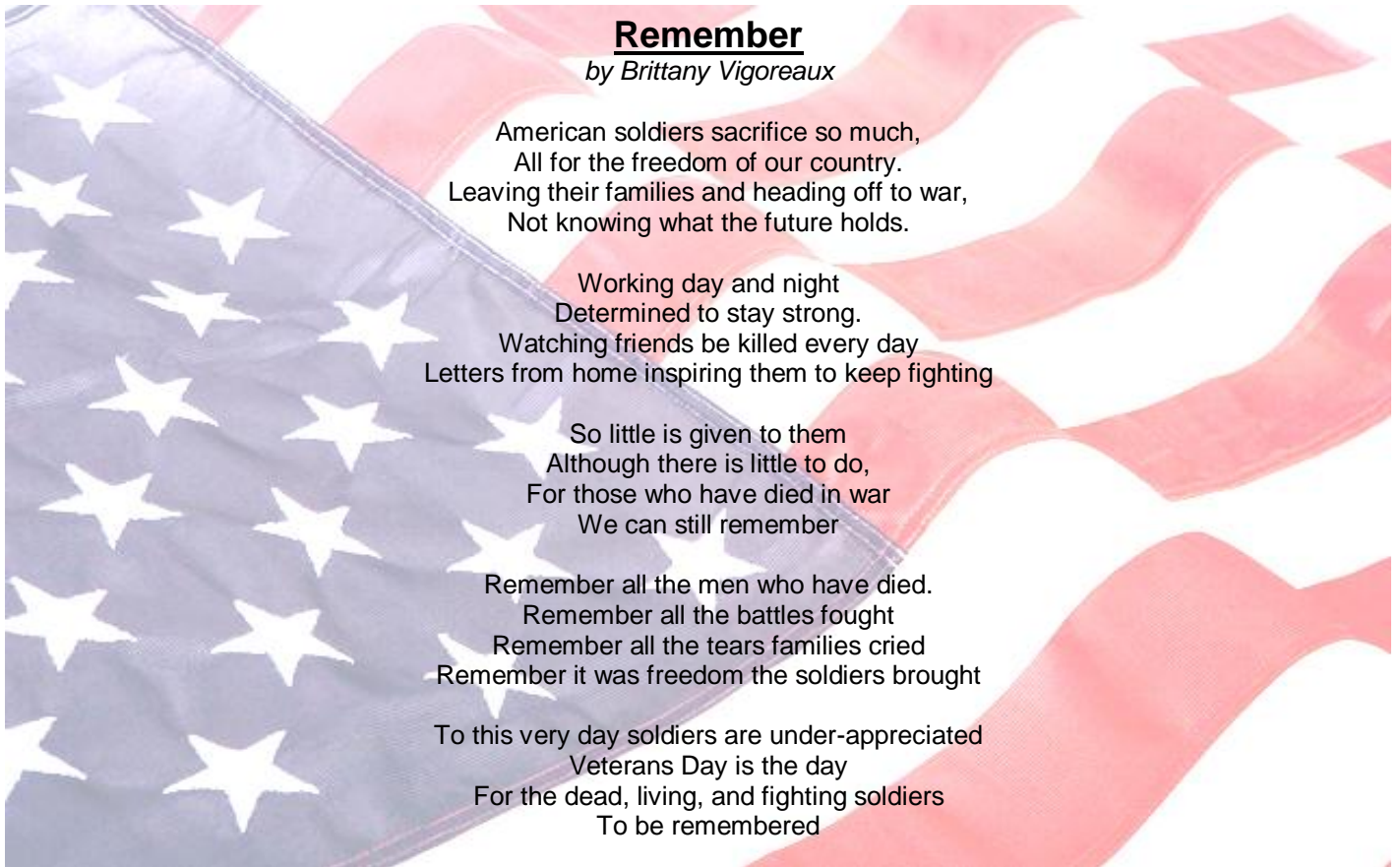
American soldiers sacrifice so much,
