I. Call to Order

III. SIP Budget

- Increase in proposed budget for Instructional Assistant.
- Reduce instructional supplies because of the increase in Instructional Assistant budget.
- Paid for LCD project.
- Moved \$1,000 into a separate line item in the budget for Library.
- We have money remaining from the Block Grant.
- We have \$44,000 left in the SLIP budget at this point.

V. New Business (Visitation)

- There were positive comments about the new science materials that were introduced during the visit and also about the instruction.
- Each teacher now has his/her own science kits.

VI. Reports

A. Principal: Robin Beacham

- Modernization will happen this summer. The plans include cement walkways, safety improvements, work on classroom walls, better ventilation, updating bathrooms to meet ADA standards, flooring and carpeting replaced and new siding. We might be able to get one portable.
- We are purchasing a bigger storage shed for Physical Education and the older shed will be used for PTA's storage. The cost of the shed will be \$5,000. There is still a total of \$13,000 for Fine Arts/Physical Education.

B. PTA

- Talked about raising money at the spring fundraiser for science lab tables that are on rollers and shelves for the library. Pictures of the shelves and tables were presented to School Site Council.
- Increase in teacher salaries and cost of living adjustments that were approved by the district will impact budget. Three and a half retroactive, 4% increase.

C. GATE

- The district is currently changing the GATE identification process/criteria.

D. ALEKS

- ALEKS has started and is being taught by Mickey Hoegh and Anne Michelena. It is a math support and intervention program and is online.
