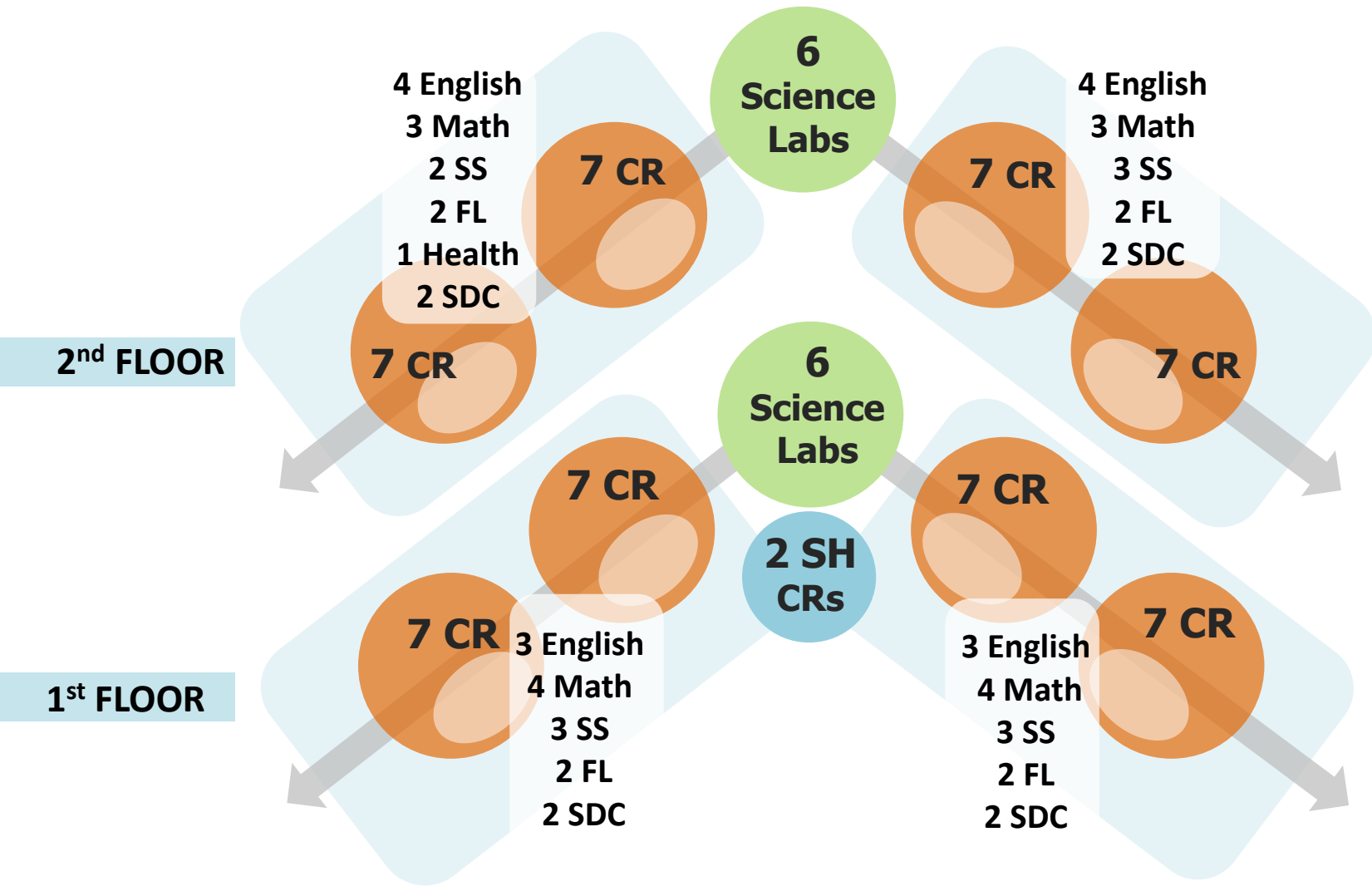


ORGANIZATION BY DISCIPLINE



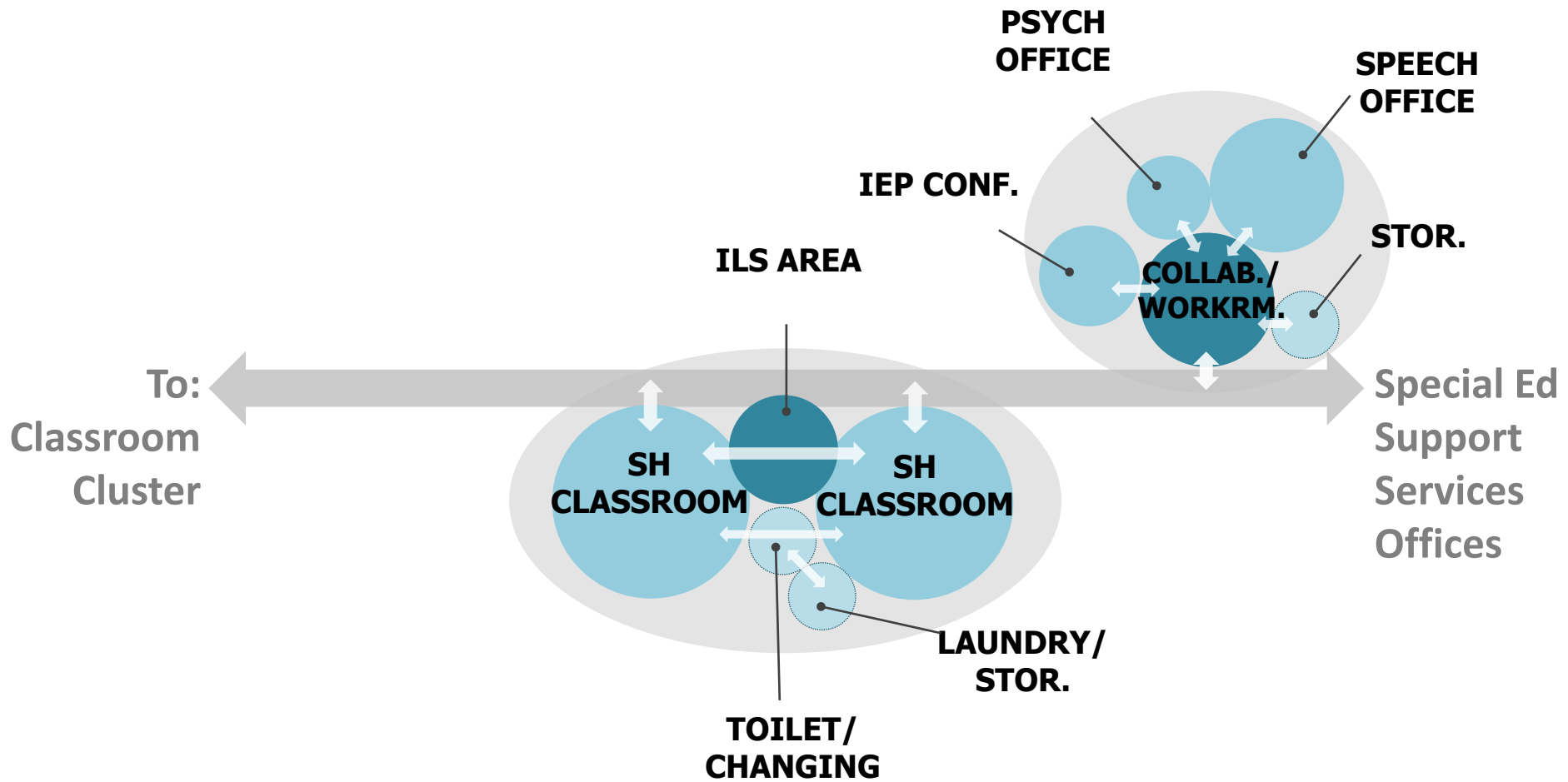
