## Career Pathways

### What is ROP?

ROP is state funded education, providing career technical education and guidance to meet identified educational standards and industry needs. ROP is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges. Coastline ROP is part of the Huntington Beach Union, Irvine, Newport-Mesa, Saddleback Valley, and Tustin Unified School Districts. Career and technical education and sequential learning is designed to improve academic skills. ROP is a course of study that combines classroom instruction with hands-on learning and classes are taught by fully credentialed teachers experienced in their related industries.

### Who can take ROP classes?

ROP courses are available to all high school juniors, seniors, persons 16 years of age or older, and to adults.

### Why take ROP classes?

ROP students can: earn grades and credits toward high school graduation; enroll in classes that satisfy a-g UC and CSU a-g requirements; gain experience for immediate employment; participate in courses that offer internships; earn certificates of completion; experience career that may assist in choosing college majors and enhance college admission; and upgrade skills, change careers, or prepare for re-entry into the workforce.

### When and where are classes offered?

The school year is divided into two 18-week semesters (fall and spring) plus a 6-week summer semester. Classes are held in businesses, industries and in high schools during and after school, evenings and Saturdays.

### What is the cost?

Courses are free to high school students (bus passes are free); a \$20 registration fee is required for adults.
