Highlights from the Irvine Unified School District's Jan. 15 Board of Education meeting

Students, parents speak in favor of a new stadium

Addressing the Board of Education, a handful of students and parents spoke in support of constructing a second district stadium adjacent to University High School. IUSD continues to explore the feasibility of building a new facility for athletics, band and pageantry performances, and other special events. An environmental impact report, expected to be completed this spring, will allow for public input and answer questions related to noise, traffic, parking and other potential impacts.

Board ratifies accord with the Irvine Administrators Association

The Board voted unanimously to ratify a salary settlement reached with the Irvine Administrators Association (IAA) for 2007-08. The agreement includes a salary increase of 3.5 percent, effective July 1, 2007, as well as an increase to existing longevity steps equivalent to an additional 0.5 percent, effective Jan. 1, 2008.

Board approves yearly budget calendar

Board members unanimously approved a budget development calendar that outlines the various steps required to formulate a spending plan for 2008-09. This calendar, a requirement under the state Education Code, concludes with the submission of a 2008-09 budget to the Orange County Department of Education on June 30, 2008.
