NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Irvine Unified School District of Orange County, California, acting by and through its Governing Board, hereinafter referred to as "DISTRICT," will receive up to, but not later than, the above-stated bid deadline, sealed bids at the place identified above for the award of a contract for the above Project.

The DISTRICT will conduct two (2) MANDATORY JOBWALKS AND CONFERENCES, one on FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 10th, 2012 at 1:00 P.M. at the University High School near the flagpole located at 4771 Campus Dr., Irvine, CA 92612 and one on TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 21st, 2012 at 1:00 P.M. at the University High School near the flagpole located at 4771 Campus Dr., Irvine, CA 92612. Any bidder failing to attend at least one entire job walk and conference will be deemed a nonresponsive bidder and will have their bid returned unopened.

In accordance with the provisions of Business and Professions Code Section 7028.15 and Public Contract Code Section 3300, the DISTRICT requires that the bidder possess the following minimum classification(s) of contractor's license(s) at the time the bid is submitted and any bidder not so licensed at the time of the bid opening will be rejected as nonresponsive:

Time is of the essence. Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the form of cash, a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in an amount not-less-than ten percent (10%) of the total bid price, payable to the DISTRICT.

The DISTRICT reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding process.

As required by Section 1773 of the California Labor Code, the California Department of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for the locality in which the work is to be performed for the Project. Copies of these wage rate determinations, entitled Prevailing Wage Scale, are maintained at the DISTRICT office located at 100 Nightmist, Irvine, CA 92618, and are available at the following website: www.dir.ca.gov. It shall be mandatory upon the successful bidder to whom the contract is awarded, and upon any subcontractor listed, to pay not less than the specified rates to all workers employed by them for the Project.

The successful bidder and any listed subcontractor(s) of this Project are subject to the oversight, monitoring and enforcement of prevailing wage requirements of the Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Standards Enforcement's Compliance Monitoring Union (CMU) and will be required to submit certified payroll records to the CMU.

No bidder may withdraw any bid for a period of forty-five (45) calendar days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22300, the Agreement will contain provisions permitting the successful bidder to substitute securities for any monies withheld by the DISTRICT to ensure performance under the Agreement or permitting payment of retentions earned directly into escrow.

The Project is subject to the Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise Program. Bidders may contact the Office of Small Business Certification and Resources (OSBCR) for resource information in locating Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises.
