



Irvine Unified School District - Surplus Properties

The Irvine Unified School District is undergoing a Facilities Strategic Plan study that focuses on future school sites, modernization/expansion of existing schools and the utilization of the District's surplus school sites.

The Irvine School District has four surplus school sites. Creekside High School at West Yale Loop and the Yale Loop Conference Center (formerly Alderwood Basics) are used for District programs. Vista Verde (Michelson Drive) and El Camino Elementary (Karen Ann Lane) are available for day/weekend rentals. There have been several inquiries into the availability of a long-term lease or sale of the District's surplus properties. Pending the final Board approval of the Facilities Strategic Plan, at this time the District is not considering long-term leases for the Vista Verde or El Camino sites.
