BENEFITS OF BREAKFAST**

School Breakfast provides ¼ the recommended amounts of protein, calcium, iron, vitamin A, and vitamin C for the day.

Eating breakfast can help improve math, reading, and standardized test scores. Breakfast helps children pay attention; perform problem-solving tasks, and improves memory.

Children who eat school breakfast are likely to have fewer absences and incidents of tardiness than those who do not.

Studies have shown that children who eat breakfast on a regular basis are less likely to be overweight. Eating breakfast as a child is important for establishing healthy habits for later in life.

By eating breakfast, students get more of important nutrients, vitamins and minerals such as calcium, dietary fiber, folate and protein.
