

CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR STANDARDS

This classroom is not an extension of the street, the movie theater, a rock concert, or a playground. It is a special environment that requires the enforcement of certain rules for learning to take place. You are responsible for knowing these rules.

1. COMMUNICATION:
 - A. Raise your hand before speaking.
 - B. Eye contact must be on the teacher, student speaker, or the assigned task
 - C. Your body language indicates that your attention is focused on the teacher, student speaker, or assigned task.
2. RESPECT:
 - A. Keep hands to yourself.
 - B. Other people's desks, desk tops, and backpacks are off limits without permission.
3. BATHROOM/DRINKS:
 - A. Remain seated if the teacher or student speaker is talking.
 - B. One person to the bathroom or drinking fountain at a time.
4. SAFETY:
 - A. Your desk chair remains in contact with the floor.

6. PERSONAL OBJECTS AND FOOD:
 - A. Personal sports equipment (including skates and skateboards) remains at home unless you have permission.
 - B. Personal belongings remain in your backpack; school books and supplies may not be on the floor.
 - C. Cellular telephones shall be deactivated and remain out of sight in your backpack during school hours.
 - D. You will not telephone home for forgotten school supplies/assignments.
 - E. Make-up is for special occasions; not school.
 - F. Alcohol and/or drug related clothing remains at home.
 - G. Eating is done at the lunch tables during break time.
 - H. Gum is an after-school treat.
7. SCHOOL ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:
 - A. Arrive school no earlier than fifteen (15) minutes prior to the start of school.
 - B. Leave school within three (3) minutes of dismissal.
8. TARDIES:
 - A. Be in your seat within three minutes of the bell.
