

## ***Enrollment Info for Residents of Woodbury and Woodbury East***

### **What schools are assigned to serve Woodbury residents?**

Woodbury residents will be served as follows:

Elementary: Woodbury

Alternately : Stonegate Elementary

Middle: Sierra Vista

High: Irvine High School

### **What alternative schools are available if we do not want a year-round calendar?**

A student may be able to attend any nearby school under the current open enrollment policy. The District is currently allowing Woodbury students to attend Westwood Basics Plus (soon to be relocated to Stonegate) on a permanent basis. Once your student is enrolled in Westwood Basics Plus, they will be guaranteed a seat through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Depending on the new housing development schedule, this allowance may change year-to-year.

### **Will there be bussing to the current Woodbury Elementary location?**

Transportation may be provided where there is sufficient ridership to operate a bus on a cost-neutral basis. A transportation fee will be determined. See Frequently Asked Questions.

### **When is the new middle school in Woodbury expected to open?**

A new middle school serving grades 7-8 is expected to open in fall 2012 pending school Board direction. The school will be located near the corner of Jeffrey and Trabuco. In the meantime, Sierra Vista Middle School will serve the Woodbury community.

### **Will open enrollment opportunities be available for middle and high school students?**
