



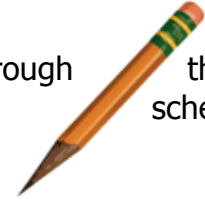

### Science

During the course of the year we will complete three science units including an Earth, physical, and life science.

#### Unit 1: Earth's Materials

Students will learn about the properties and composition of soil and rocks, and about the uses of rocks, plants, soil and water. They will observe weathering and erosion and discover how fossils provide clues about the earth's history.

#### Unit 2: Matter, Energy, and Forces

Students will learn that energy and matter have multiple forms and can be changed from one form to another. They will explore how forces and machines relate to energy.

**Field Trip:** Discovery Science Center— Forces and Motion, Energy and Light

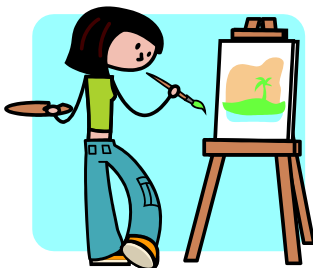
#### Unit 3: Life Cycles

Students will learn the stages in the life cycles of animals and plants and how life cycles differ. They will learn about inherited traits and how living things of one kind vary. They will discover the environmental effects on plants.
