



## Second Grade Classroom Discipline Plan

In the classroom, we strive to teach the students to develop independent work habits and positive social skills. We have several plans in place to reinforce appropriate behavior as students learn these important life skills.

### **Positive Reinforcement:**

“Mark-a-box” – Students demonstrating appropriate behavior are recognized by the teacher and asked to “mark-a-box.” On Friday, all students who have filled at least two rows on their “mark-a-box” will receive a “blue card” which can be saved up to earn: lunch with the principal (10 blue cards), lunch with the teacher (10 additional blue cards), and finally the privilege of helping a kindergarten or first grade teacher (10 additional blue cards.)

Students also receive a R.O.P.E.S. coupon if they completely fill their “mark-a-box” page. When a student has five R.O.P.E.S. coupons, they are entered into the monthly drawing for prizes to be announced at the Friday morning flag deck. In addition, students will receive a raffle ticket. A grade level drawing will be held each Friday. Winners will be allowed to choose from the grade level treasure chest or receive a R.O.P.E.S. coupon.

Our grade level will have a special Friday activity for students who have completed all work and turned in complete and correct homework, VIP Folders, and Communication Sheets. Any student who receives a Meadow Park Warning Slip or Citation will not be able to participate in the special Friday activity.

### **Consequences:**

Occasionally, students require reminders to “stay on task.” In these cases, “reminder cards” are given as a consequence for failing to heed the teacher’s verbal reminders. The following are the “reminder cards” we use in class:

- Red Hand - calling out without raising one’s hand
- Yellow Foot - being out of seat without permission
- Green Chatterbox - talking when not appropriate
- Blue Ears - failing to listen and follow directions

When a student receives five or more reminder cards in one week, the reminder cards received, along with a Student Bulletin requiring a parent signature, will be sent home. The student will also miss the special Friday activity and he/she will attend study hall instead.
