SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2009-2010

- Earned an Academic Performance Index Growth Score (API) of 964.
- 91% of Canyon View students in English Language Arts and 93% in Mathematics scored at the proficient or advanced levels on the 2009 California Standards Tests.
- Increased the percent of students at or above benchmark on LPA for grades K-3.
- Utilized regular analysis of grade level Common Assessments, Literacy Performance Assessment data, IOLA assessment data and IUSD Writing Assessments to inform instructional decisions in core curricular areas.
- Continued our work as a Professional Learning Community to monitor student learning, adjust instruction based on student achievement data, and provide interventions for students based on individual need.
- Identified essential standards, prior skills needed, developed examples of rigor, common assessments and timeline for teaching in both language arts and math.
- Provided grade level blocks of time to deliver differentiated instruction.
- Fully implemented Early Intervention Reading Model (EIRM) in grades K-2.
- Created before and after school intervention programs and extended learning opportunities.
- Utilized our Information Resource Center to develop integrated, technology-based problem-solving units for GATE students.
- Continued implementation of student-led Video Production Studio to produce school broadcasts through our Star Cam program.
- Logged more than 21,000 parent volunteer hours.
- Involved students in on-going community service with a Families Forward food drive, Pennies for Prevention, Hearts for Haiti and supply drive for the Irvine Animal Shelter.
- Augmented fine arts instruction with PTA-sponsored Art Masters program for K-6 and classroom music lessons for grades K-3.
- Partnered with PTA to continue “Math-to-Achieve” and “Reading Counts” Incentive Programs K-6.
- Continued IPSF ACE program which featured about 10 classes in each of the fall and winter sessions.
- Held our Jog-a-Thon and broke Jog-a-thon fund raising record, again!!
- Hosted our annual “Taste of Canyon View” which brought together our diverse cultures for an afternoon of food, music, dance and games.
- Purchased Tuesday, Thursday lunch time activity program from the City of Irvine
- Participated in district and community events such as Harvest Cup, Irvine Hoops Classic, IUSD’s Honor Orchestra and Chorus, Irvine Jr. Games, Science Fair, and Astounding Inventions.
- Developed a character development program based on Coach Wooden’s Pyramid of Success.
- Recognized over 150 students monthly for their commitment to demonstrating STAR behavior.
