SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENTS FOR 2007-2008:

- Utilized grade level planning meetings for ongoing analysis of assessment data and student work including IOLA, Literacy Performance Assessment, Writing Assessment data, CST and CELDT
- Analyzed student assessment data through staff meetings, parent conferences, Title 1 Parent Meeting, newsletters, IEPs, and SSTs
- Participated in IUSD professional development and outside conferences addressing the needs of our student community as appropriate such as Early Intervention Reading Model training, Primary Literacy Project, Launch Point, GATE training, Professional Learning Communities, Autism Spectrum Disorder, PLATO Data Management System, CELDT, EL standards, and strategies used with EL students, airliners, and utilizing LCD projectors
- Selected staff participated in Response to Instruction and Professional Learning Communities trainings
- Earned an API Base Score of 923
- Received a statewide rank of 10 and a similar school rank of 10 on API
- Serviced Title I students in Neufeld Math, Read naturally, and Read 180
- Obtained IPSF grants for Board Maker, Signing Time Videos, and Fraction Manipulatives for Upper Elementary Students
- Continued participation in district Early Intervention Reading Model in grades K-2
- Continued Irvine Online Assessment throughout the year in grades 4-6
- Collected cell phones for soldiers and Kids' Meal toys for Spencer's Treasures
- Served as a Professional Development School for student teachers from University of California at Irvine and Chapman University
- Jumped our hearts out for Jump Rope for Heart while raising over \$4000
- Raised over \$6,000 through the Meadow Park Foundation Purchased new computers for student use
- Continued with a school-wide R.O.P.E.S. respect program
- Participated in transition meetings from pre-school to elementary school and from elementary school to middle school including Kindergarten Round-up, transition IEPs, and participated in transition meeting from elementary school to middle school
- Students participated in IUSD Honor Orchestra and Chorus, Harvest Cup, Junior Games, Science Fair, Constitution Day, as well as K-2 music all sponsored by the Parent Teacher Association
