**SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2009-2010**

- Earned California Distinguished School Award.
- Achieved an API score of 908, a statewide rating of 10, and similar schools rank of 10 meeting Federal Adequate Yearly Progress targets as required under No Child Left Behind.
- Held weekly Professional Learning Community meetings to analyze student progress and design curricular lessons.
- Created grade level formative assessments to guide instruction.
- Utilized a Response to Instruction model for our English Language Arts program.
- Delivered EIRM (Early Intervention Reading Model) and SIPPS (Systematic Instruction in Phoneme Awareness) instruction to at-risk kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students.
- Provided remedial Mathematics and English Language Arts instruction through Extended Learning classes after school.
- Unwrapped and repacked the Mathematics standards in Kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grades.
- Held Title 1 Parent Night to support parent understanding of the curriculum.
- Received 92% score on Orange County Department of Education PBIS evaluation.
- Implemented use of Panther PRIDE team to support behaviorally at-risk students.
- Presented Function of Behaviors and School-wide Positive Reinforcement concepts at County event.
- Planned and conducted full day PBIS staff development for all UP staff.
- Recognized students for showing PRIDE character values through monthly principal drawings and trimester community assemblies.
- Celebrated U.P.'s diverse community through week long Multicultural Celebration.
- Continued IPSF Grant for Playground Support and Lunch Time Activities through City of Irvine to promote inclusion of all students in activities at lunch.
- Held a successful community carnival.
- Participated in Team Kids Service Challenge.
- Conducted service learning projects for local Animal Shelter and the Irvine Regional Park.
- Donated \$5,600 to the American Heart Association through our Jump for Heart event.
- Trained staff and conducted a full scale disaster preparedness drill.
