#### ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE INDEX (API) ADEQUATE YEARLY PROGRESS (AYP)

The Academic Performance Index (API) is a numeric index or scale that ranges from a low of 200 to a high of 1000. The state set 800 as the interim API score that schools should strive to meet. Schools that fall short of 800 are required to meet annual growth targets until their goal is achieved. Schools that already meet or exceed the 800 API should continue working to improve the academic performance of all students.

Adequate Yearly Progress is a federal measure based on student participation rates in testing and scores on the California Standards Tests, and the school's API. If a school does not meet its goals in any one of these areas, it has not made AYP overall.

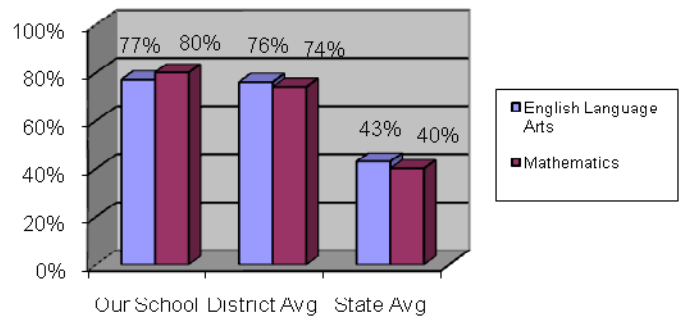

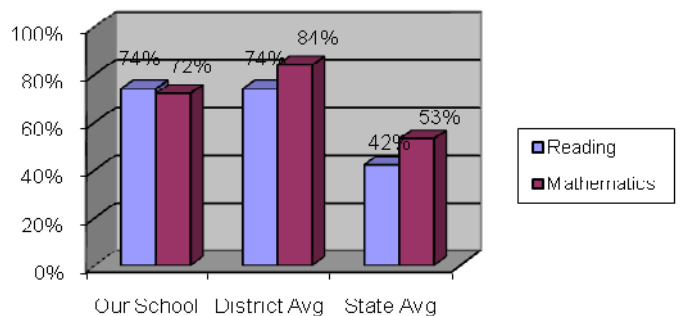
##### English Language Arts and Mathematics



#### CAT-6 TEST, 2007

The California Achievement Test (CAT-6) is administered to all students in grades 3. Reading and mathematics results from the CAT-6 are reported as the percent of tested students scoring at or above the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile (the national average).
