Currently, the Families Forward food pantry in Irvine serves over **250 low-income families** each month. **Families Forward relies entirely on schools** and other members of the community to donate the food that is given to families. For families with children that qualify for the school-subsidized lunch program, **summer vacation puts extra strain on the family budget**, and they must also find daycare during the summer months. **Providing food can often relieve the pressure** on a family's budget and allow them to pay their rent or mortgage and prevent their becoming homeless. This year with the additional impact of the economic crisis, we are anticipating an **even greater increase in demand for our food** distribution services.
