

IUSD UHS Computer Network Student Login Information

IUSD Information Services assigns each student a unique Novell User Account. This account permits students to log into computers campus-wide as well as use the WiFi with your personal computers.

The naming convention is:

- Single digit of high school graduation year with the exemption of 2010 which requires 2 digits.
- First 8 characters (or less) of last name
- First 8 characters (or less) of first name
 - Example: Marycarol Butterworth - Graduation year 2013
 - Username: 13butterwomarycaro
 - Example: John Smith - Graduation year 2014
 - Username: 14SmithJohn

Because the data comes directly from Eagle records, legal names are used, not nicknames. In the event of a duplicate name across the entire district, an incremental number will be added to the end of the username.

The Permanent ID # printed on the ID cards will be the initial password. After logging in for the first time, you will be prompted to change the password. It must be at least 5 characters. Please choose a password that can be remembered easily because only you have access to the password.

Most problems related to your Novell account can be solved immediately by your coming to the Library.

Computer Lab

As you are aware, running and maintaining the computer labs in the library and around campus is expensive. With the cost of printers, paper, ink, etc., we encourage you to donate to the printing and computer maintenance via the webstore during the registration process.

Printing and Copying

A self-service copier is available for student use in the Library. Copies are black and white and 15 cents each. Quarters, dimes, and nickels are used; there is no dollar changer. Color printing is 50¢ per page.
