

Dear Parents and Students:

IUSD Secondary Summer School will be held at University High School from June 28th to August 6th. Classes will be Monday through Friday except for the July 5th holiday. For the first time ever all four Irvine high schools will be attending the same school site. Although a change from past practice, this is an exciting opportunity that will allow students access to course offerings they may not have had in the past.

Parents and students are encouraged to discuss summer school enrollment with their counselor. All registration documents and information can be found in, and turned in to, your student's current (or scheduled) high school. All times, fees, rules and deadlines are final. Students must pay careful attention to the prerequisites listed for this summer's remediation courses. Only those students who meet the prerequisites will get to enroll in those remediation courses offered free of cost.

This year enrichment classes will be offered by IUSD with the assistance of the Irvine Public Schools Foundation. This program is part of a unique partnership IPSF has with the Irvine Unified School District. Students can enroll in these enrichment courses for a fee payable to IPSF. This revenue is used to fund the Summer School program and provide further assistance to the Irvine Public Schools in this challenging time.

Summer Athletic and Activity Camps are available at various times throughout the summer. These camps are sponsored by each High School's Athletic Booster Clubs and are not run in conjunction with the Summer School program. Contact your home school's Athletic Director or Coach for information on dates, times and fees for these programs.

Registration documents will be available at each high school and online the week of March 29th. Completed registration cards are to be returned to the designated location at your school between April 12th and May 7th. All fees must be paid with a check or money order. Cash will not be accepted. Students will only be allowed to register for Summer School if all fee's and holds have been cleared from their current accounts. A lottery will be administered for impacted classes. Those enrichment courses that do not have sufficient enrollment will be collapsed after the registration deadline. Students will be notified and fees will be refunded.

Summer School is an incredible opportunity for students to have a second chance, get remediation, take a course they cannot take during the regular school year, or simply get ahead. If you have any questions please contact your school's summer school representative.
