The upcoming conference will focus on student goals for second grade. We like to use this time to talk about your child's academic strengths as well as areas that you'd like to see targeted for improvement.

Attached to this letter is a student worksheet to help your child choose learning goals for second grade. This worksheet should be completed as a joint effort between you and your child. Talk about what academic areas or work habits could use improvement. Make your goals realistic and achievable. The back of the page has goals that students have used in previous years. However, you are not limited to using these goals.

The second half of the worksheet focuses on reading goals. In second grade we have a wide disparity between student reading levels. Therefore, we'd like every child to choose an individual reading goal. Please help your child to choose a book (or a series of books) that they can read accurately and independently right now. Then ask them to choose a book (or series) that they'd like to be able to read by the end of the year.
