

Dear Parents,

I have spoken with the students about the Sight Word Soldier Program, but I want to inform you about how we reward and motivate the students to study and learn as many sight words as possible. Those incentives really work wonders! ☺

Every Tuesday, a parent helper will test your child on their sight words. She records the unit the child is to be tested on and if the student identifies all the words in the unit, she will continue to test them until the child can no longer immediately identify the words. This unit becomes the list of words sent home with your child each week. If you study the words with your child and they immediately learn them, then please print the next unit off our website and continue studying the rest of the week. I want your child to work at their own pace and if they're ready, keep going!

For every 100 words (or every 10 units) your child learns, they will earn a dog tag. Each dog tag is a different color and shape. They are added to their chain, which will hang in our classroom. These sight words are an extremely important part of your child's reading success, so thank you for your support in helping your child learn them. They are so excited when they recognize them in their reading in class! Happy studying! ☺
