Week 1: February 6th - February 10th

1. Please read the Research Report Information with your parent.
2. Contact and set up the interview.

Week 2: Feb. 13th - Feb. 17th

1. Interview your community helper.
2. You and/or a parent takes notes. (OK to tape record or video)

Week 3: Feb. 20th - 24th Chapter 1: On the Job

1. Use your interview notes and the rough draft paper to write a 5 sentence paragraph.
2. Have an adult proofread it.
3. Copy it neatly onto final copy paper. (typed is ok)
4. Complete your illustration for the final copy. Remember to write the chapter title on your illustration.
