- I. Call to order
- II. SSC Role-technically there are no longer SLIP funds from the State as it is a Tier III funded program however there will still be a discretionary allocation from the District. SSC's will still exist to oversee EIA and Title 1 expenditures and review School Plans.
- III. Staff Development plans and review –Erica shared Westpark's staff development plans for the 2009-2010 school year. On July 27, 2009 the staff met with the other year round schools to review the PLC concept and talk about cultural shifts. In September we again we met with Vista Verde on technology.
