We then visited Mrs. Crane and Mrs. Schultz's 6<sup>th</sup> grade shared teaching classrooms as well as Mrs. Briseno's 6<sup>th</sup> grade class as they were working independently on writing. In Mrs. Bentley's 1<sup>st</sup> grade class the students were each using white dry-erase math boards, these have been very useful for their learning process. Ms. Schick's 5<sup>th</sup> grade class shared their CD creations with us. Each student recorded their own music and created CD covers for their music. The Kindergarten classes were transitioning from early bird to late bird while we were visiting. All in all the tour was very informational and we hope to have them at least twice a year.
